The Moog Minimoog Model D is easily one of the most important and recognizable synths of all time. While well-known and loved for the rich tones of its oscillators and filters, it's the countless artists the Minimoog has inspired that have earned this synth its legendary status. Michael Jackson's "Thriller" may not have been the most successful record ever, and classic albums by Nine Inch Nails, Dr. Dre, Kraftwerk, and countless others would have been born with a Minimoog as part of the equation.

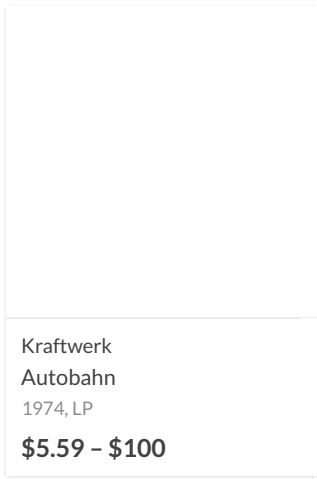
5 Classic Songs Utilizing the Minimoog Model D

“Fast forward past the acoustic guitars and vocal layers on E.L.P.'s *Lucky Man*, to the last 90 seconds. That bending Keith Emerson lead line is the Model D with the Glide switch engaged.”

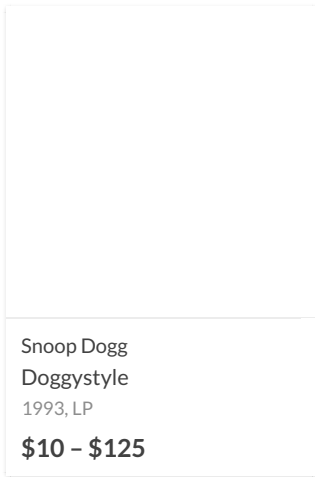
